



Prepare for Medicare Checklist

Use this checklist to prepare for enrollment and ensure you start receiving benefits when you turn 65

Get started today

Learn about Medicare and mark key dates on your calendar

- Download your Free Information Kit at UHMAPMedicareEligible.com
- Call 855-210-1072 to speak with a Local Licensed Agent by phone, over coffee, or at your home

Confirm your eligibility and request your Medicare card

- Call Social Security at 800-772-1213, 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday to Friday, or visit SSA.gov/Benefits/Medicare. If you're already receiving Social Security, you'll be automatically enrolled in Medicare when you turn 65, but you'll want to explore your options beforehand.

3 months before you turn 65

Enroll in UCLA Health Medicare Advantage plan

- With your Medicare card handy, enroll in one of our two plans by calling 855-210-1072 or visiting UHMAPMedicareEligible.com

On or after your 65th birthday

Avoid late-enrollment penalties

- If you're no longer working**, you only have until 3 months after your 65th birthday to enroll and avoid potential penalties
- If you or your spouse have health insurance from a job**, ask your benefits manager if you need to sign up for Medicare Parts A & B when you turn 65. If you don't sign up, your employer's insurance might not cover the costs of services you get.
